As you'll see from our website we're a market town practice offering high-quality family medical care with a commitment to teaching at all levels.

We are a close knit partnership of seven doctors, the majority of whom have medical interests complimenting their work in General Practice:

Stephen Blake and Caroline Keenan are our current trainers, but all members of the practice team are involved in training and tutorials, including attached staff such as midwives, CPNs, District Nurses and Health Visitors. We have been training GP Registrars and medical students for many years as a practice, and often have other learners (e.g. Gynae SHOs, Student Nurses) with us.

We cover a wide geographical area of approximately 10 miles radius, and dispense to half of our 8000 patients. We manage inpatients in our Community Hospital and also look after 4 Nursing and Residential Homes. We do our own minor surgery including Vasectomies and Mirena Coil fitting in the practice. We have excellent IT systems and are paper-free with all post being converted to electronic format. We are enabled for 'GP2GP' electronic notes transfer and Electronic Transfer of Prescriptions (ETP). We have open lists which means patients are free to see whichever partner they wish, although we advise a 'usual doctor' preference to aid continuity. We have achieved consistently high QOF scores and are actively involved in Practice Based Commissioning.

All of these varied features mean we can offer Registrars a very rounded learning experience. We work with our Registrars to make sure their learning is tailored to their individual needs, and do our very best to make them feel valued and involved. As one former Registrar commented,
